



K4 Registration Information

Three options for K4:

- Each option includes books
- Options A & B require \$150 registration fee, a \$100 new student fee and completed enrollment papers.
- Option C requires only completed enrollment papers
- Lunch may be purchased with Options A or B
- All options require that parents purchase school uniforms from RC Uniforms (*Boys' shirts and Girls' shirts and skirts/skorts must be purchased from the uniform company.*)

Option A

- \$3,250 (paid by parent) plus the VPK Allotment for the full-day program
- Can be paid in 10 monthly payments (\$325 per month)
- Parent must obtain a certificate of eligibility from Early Learning Coalition.
 - ❖ take child's birth certificate
 - ❖ take proof of Florida residence

Option B (only available to children who do not qualify for VPK)

- Full-day program (8:00-3:00) \$4,100.00 yearly (\$410.00 per month)
- Can be paid in 10 monthly payments

Option C (no cost to parent)

- VPK Allotment for 3-hour program only (8:15-11:15)
(*Class hours determined by space availability*)
- Parent must obtain Certificate of Eligibility from Early Learning Coalition.
- No lunch available

There is no discount for the 2nd or 3rd child under the VPK program.

K4 Information Sheet

See the enclosed flyer from the Early Learning Coalition to learn more about what is necessary for you to receive the VPK funds for your child's K4 education.

- 1) You do not have to accept voluntary pre-kindergarten funds for your child to be enrolled in our program, but obviously, it is a financial benefit you may want to consider.
- 2) The VPK allocation only pays for three (3) hours of instructional time; other costs are additional.
- 3) Lunches are \$3.00* per day or you may pack a lunch for your child.
- 4) K4 students must wear school uniforms (girls' dresses, blouses & skirts or skorts / boys' shirts) which the parent purchases from **RC Uniforms**.
- 5) Books are included in the VPK allocation.
- 6) To register your child for the 8:00-3:00 program, you must pay the \$150.00 registration fee and the \$100 new student fee. If you are only enrolling your child in the 3-hour instructional program there are no additional fees, but enrollment papers must be completed and turned in.
- 7) It will be the school's decision as to what section and what classroom your child will be placed.
- 8) All parents must sign the school's attendance and discipline policies upon registration for the child to be accepted in the VCA K4 program.
- 9) Parents and/or students not complying and cooperating with school policies will be subject to having their child dismissed from the program.

Parents please note the following policies of Victory Christian Academy:

- 1) Boys enrolled at VCA must have traditional haircuts – off the neck, off the eyebrows, off the ears. Braids and earrings are not allowed.
- 2) Tattoos (permanent or temporary) are not allowed for boys or girls.
- 3) Girls' uniform skirts/skorts must be no shorter than the top of the knee (both front and back of the leg) when standing in a normal erect position as well as when seated.
