

Conduct and Discipline: Victory Summer Day Camp reserves the right to refuse enrollment and/or to request the withdrawal of any camper whose conduct or character in the opinion of the director is considered a harmful influence to other campers. When such becomes necessary, there is no refund on registration fees or tuition. If a camper's behavior is such that he or she cannot be controlled by the counselor in charge, the camp reserves the right to use the appropriate discipline necessary to gain the camper's respect (corporal punishment will not be used). Campers will be held responsible for replacing anything they break. Foul language, fighting, tobacco (in any form), or drugs will not be tolerated. Comic books, playing cards, dice, toy guns or knives, pocket knives, digital devices and/or Poké Mon or Harry Potter articles (toys, clothing, etc.) are not permitted.

Dress Code: Victory Summer Day Camp is a Christian ministry. Please respect our dress code guidelines and do not put us in a position to have to enforce them.

All students must wear non-marking shoes (no flip-flops) in order to protect our gym floor. Campers need to wear tennis or athletic shoes.

GIRLS: Mid-knee length culottes, mid-knee length shorts or loose-fitting slacks are acceptable. No short-shorts, midriffs, mini-skirts or skin-tight clothing will be allowed. No pictures, words, etc. on the back of pants, shorts or skirts.

BOYS: Jeans with a t-shirt or sports shirt are recommended. Long shorts (to the top of the knee) may be worn. No tank tops are to be worn.

Hairstyles: I Cor. 11:14, 15 Dyes, bleaches, and/or "punk" cuts are not acceptable for boys or girls. **BOYS** must have a traditional boy's haircut, no layer cuts, no lines, no tails of any kind. Boys' hair may not come over the ears or past the collar of a tailored shirt. **GIRLS'** hairstyles must also be traditional

Swimming: **GIRLS** must wear modest one-piece bathing suits. TWO-PIECE BATHING SUITS ARE NOT TO BE WORN. **BOYS** are to wear long, loose-fitting swim suits or hemmed cut-offs. Girls and boys swim at different times. Kindergarten campers use wading pools here on campus. Elementary campers are transported to a private pool. Swim-time is well supervised!

Canteen: Campers will have canteen privileges in the mid-afternoon. During canteen-time, campers may purchase extra soft drinks, candy, snacks and ice cream. The cost of canteen items is **NOT** included in the tuition. All campers will receive a mid-afternoon snack and drink.

Registration: The registration forms must be filled out completely for each camper. Please list more than one emergency contact phone number. Check each week the camper will be at camp. This allows us to have the staff we need for proper supervision. Changes to weeks reserved can be made with at least one week's notice.

Reservation Fee: A \$10.00 reservation fee per camper for each reserved week must accompany the registration form or be paid at least two weeks in advance. Due to staffing, we may not be able to accept a camper who has not paid the reservation fee two weeks prior to the week of camp. **RESERVATION FEES ARE NOT REFUNDABLE.**

Tuition: The reservation fee for the current week of camp will be deducted from the \$120.00 tuition when your child reports to camp (\$10.00 per week). If the reservation is not received in advance, the full weekly camp fee **MUST be paid in cash the first day** the camper reports to camp for the unreserved week. **Any returned check** will result in the account being placed on a cash only basis for the remainder of the summer. **There is no discount for partial days or weeks – including holidays.**

Late Fee & Non-payment: Weekly payments not received by noon on Tuesday of the camp week will incur a \$25.00 late fee. If payment has not been made by 6:00 PM on Tuesday, the camper will not be allowed to return to camp until the amount due is paid.

Before and After Care: There is no additional fee for the time before 8:00 AM or after 4:00 PM. If a camper is not picked up by 6:00 PM there is an extra charge of \$15.00 for every 15 minutes after 6:00 PM (per camper—all ages).
