

**STANDARDS OF CONDUCT**  
**5th - 12th Grades**

Victory Christian Academy holds that the Bible is the infallible, divine Word of God and that salvation by faith in Christ is the initial step in the Christian life. There is adequate Biblical basis for the idea of spiritual growth into the image of Christ (Rom. 8:29), which is the work of the Holy Spirit (II Cor. 3:18). This growth begins with the initial act of saving faith and continues throughout life. The Holy Spirit makes the Christian conscious of the Biblical demands for a holy life which fulfills both God's moral law and high law of love (Matt. 22:37-39, Rom. 13:8-10, Gal. 5:15). The result is a life consecrated unto God and separated from the world.

Victory Christian Academy must, therefore, provide an environment conducive to the spiritual growth and development of young people who are not yet mature Christians. A standard of conduct based on the following Biblical imperatives is necessary to provide such an environment. All of the activities of the Christian must be subordinated to the glory of God who indwells us (I Cor. 8:9, 12, 13, 10:32). The Christian will endeavor to avoid practices which cause the loss of sensitivity to the spiritual needs of the world and loss of the Christian's physical, mental, or spiritual well-being (I Cor. 9:27).

A sense of the need for spiritual growth in the light of these principles has led Victory Christian to adopt the following standards that are conducive to the environment that will best promote the spiritual welfare of the student. The school, therefore, requests each student, whether at **home, school, or elsewhere** to refrain from:

- ❖ swearing
- ❖ use of tobacco products
- ❖ abuse of drugs
- ❖ all forms of dancing
- ❖ indecent language
- ❖ drinking alcoholic beverages
- ❖ involvement with any form of pornographic literature (computer/internet, books, etc.)
- ❖ gambling
- ❖ involvement in rock or so-called "Christian rock" music or concerts
- ❖ immorality

Students are also expected to maintain Christian standards in courtesy, kindness, morality and honesty.

The selection of the restrictions mentioned in this pledge may appear arbitrary to some, but while not condemning others who see differently, Victory Christian Academy believes that the restrictions named are outstanding types of conduct which are detrimental to the standards established as its objective.

Students are expected to abide by the standards throughout their enrollment whether at home, school, or elsewhere. Students found to be out of harmony with the Victory Christian Academy ideals of work and life will be invited to withdraw whenever the general welfare demands it, even though there may be no special breach of conduct.

In this atmosphere of definite and positive Christian standards of conduct, good scholastic planning, and personal interest between faculty and student, there is fine opportunity for development of strong Christian character.
