1.	The administration has full responsibility for placing my child in the proper grade.
2.	Since the fees do not cover the actual cost of educating each child, we recognize that our participation is needed i prayer, service, and gifts in order to properly share in his training.
3.	The school reserves the right to dismiss any student who himself or whose parent does not respect its spiritus standards, <i>Statement of Faith</i> , philosophy, or who does not fully cooperate in the educational process. Parents wh are not in harmony with the school's Christian teachings or discipline policies may be denied admission for their child or may have their child administratively withdrawn.
4.	We understand students are accepted on a conditional basis. If acceptable progress has not been shown by the en of the first grading period, the student shall be withdrawn from the Victory Christian Academy and placed in a program more designed to meet his needs. The teacher's judgment shall be relied upon for the acceptability of his progress.
5.	We pledge our loyalty to the aims and ideals of the Academy and will bring any and all questions and criticism directly to the administration so that they may be properly considered by those in authority.
6.	We have read the <u>Statement of Faith</u> and the <u>Philosophy of Education</u> and are willing to have our child trained i accordance with them.
7.	It is our understanding that it is the school's policy to make no refunds on registration fees.
8.	We give Victory Christian Academy permission for our child to take part in all school activities, including bus trips sports activities, and school sponsored trips away from the school premises.
9.	We believe that discipline is necessary for the welfare of each student as well as for the entire school. We give permission for our child's teacher and/or other agent of the school to make and enforce classroom regulations in manner consistent with Christian principles and discipline as set forth in the Scriptures. (VCA does not administed corporal punishment.)
10.	We agree to hold the school and its agents harmless for any liability to our child or any guardian or parent thereobecause of any claims on behalf of our child against the school or any agent thereof because of any injury or allege injury to our child. Should legal action, for any reason, be taken against Victory Christian Academy or any employe or agent thereof, on our child's behalf and the school or its agent not be found at fault, we agree to pay any attorne fees, court fees, damages or other costs that Victory Christian Academy or its agent should incur to defend itse against such action, and would immediately withdraw our child from school as soon as such action has begun.
11.	All music groups perform in various programs during the year. All elementary and secondary programs are considered part of the curriculum, and the attendance of all students in the programs is vitally important. We understand that if our child does not attend a program, his music grade will be adversely affected. Participation is programs is expected as part of the student and parent's cooperation. Lack of participation (without a valid reason) may be grounds for not allowing a student to re-enroll.
12.	We understand that it is our responsibility to obtain and read the entire contents of the <u>Parent-Student Handbook</u> , and we are willing to abide by all the regulations stated therein.
13.	This <u>Statement of Cooperation</u> will be in effect for as long as this student (or others to be enrolled) attends Victor Christian Academy whether it be in the daycare, kindergarten, elementary, junior/senior high or summer school.
14.	We understand that should our marital status change that it is our responsibility to have a corrected <u>Statement of Cooperation</u> signed, updated, and delivered to Victory Christian Academy.
